Motion to approve minutes of last meeting by Blessing, second by N. Lewis.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

- 1. Beginning balance, \$4745.10
- 2. Deposits
 - a) Cummins Power, \$500
 - b) D. Nielsen, (18th of April Foundation) 500
 - c) Murray State Bank, 100

- 3. Paid out

TAXES:

- 1. Nikki Lewis and Pat Zeigler met with Jeff Hamernik, CPA, to file taxes.
 - a) Per Hamernik, MFF only needs to file taxes once per year, by MAY 15th.
 - b) Asked how much MFF can carry over each year, before it's no longer considered 'non-profit' and he said "millions"...so MFF really doesn't have to worry about that. We would only have to pay on any interest earned.

 - d) Ask village about painting the streets for 5K route

- 1. Mike Zeigler reported that Eric Dennis has again given permission for MFF to use the school for another pancake feed on Saturday morning, May 21, during Murray's garage sales.
