## WEBSITE:

- 1. April Schmeckpeper offered to be administrator of website.
- 2. Per Nikki Lewis, Hammons said that she'll send website info to Schmeckpeper and Hensch. Domain name is owned by Jon Rowe. He'll release the rights to us if we want to go to another server.
- 3. Schmeckpeper would prefer to handle website herself.
- 4. Zeigler suggested that we need to have two Board members with website access, in the event Schmeckpeper is unable to take care of it.
- 5. Zeigler will contact Jon Rowe and Melissa Hammons to forward any information concerning transfer of to Schmeckpeper.

## ART CONTEST:

- 1. Suggested last spring by CPA, Jeff Hamernik, our own logo should be used on volunteer shirts, media, etc., but is especially important for letterhead for tax purposes.
- 2. Need to contact school art instructors for guidance on proper administration of contest.
