CALL to ORDER by Hensch at 7:09 p.m.

Motion to approve minutes of September 6, 2016 meeting by Hensch, 2nd by Blessing. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT by Hensch, in N. Lewis' absence:

1. Beginning balance: \$7,092.94.

2. Debits: Ck #1056 given to Pat Zeigler tonight for supplies, \$21.71;

3. Ending balance: \$7,071.23.

4. Motion by Blessing, 2nd by Zeigler to approve treasurer's report. Motion carried.

WEBSITE:

- 1. April Schmeckpeper contacted Zeigler about website.
- 2. Per Schmeckpeper, we could keep present website or start from scratch with another one that has an 'open' domain name, either of which would cost approximately \$40/year.
- 3. Motion by Hensch, that to maintain consistency throughout, with Facebook and other media, to keep the current website. 2nd by Blessing. Motion carried.

ART CONTEST:

- 1. Contest to be open to Conestoga School only, grades 7-12.
- 2. Board and guests at February 7, 2017 meeting will determine winner.
- 3. Zeigler will check into cost to have logo trademarked.
 - A) What to do if trademark infringes on another similar one?
- 4. All artwork becomes property of MFF.
- 5. Winning submissions will receive gift cards to Dick Blick Art Supply Store or some other type gift card in amounts of \$250 for 1st place; \$150, 2nd place.
- 6. It is preferred that submissions be electronically submitted, however, paper and poster board items would be acceptable and considered, as long as design could be easily scanned, digitized, and clearly legible.
- 7. Designs are to be all original, patriotic in nature, any color.
- 8. Design will be used on MFF letterhead, shirts, media, etc.
- 9. Hensch will speak to art teacher at Conestoga for further tips.

BINGO FUNDRAISER NIGHT:

- 1. Zeigler to contact Eric Dennis at Conestoga Elementary to confirm Friday, November 11th, 6-9:00 p.m.
- 2. Concessions to be sold are chili, hotdogs, chips, pop, coffee, water.

- 5. Cash prizes will be awarded.
 - A) Mike Zeigler will seek gift cards for other Bingo prizes.
 - B) Hensch will check with zoo for toy prizes.
- 6. Zeiglers will donate 10# ground beef for chili.
- 7. Zeigler also has gift cards from No Frills and Hy-Vee, combined total around \$30 which can be used for concession supplies.

OPEN DISCUSSION:

- 1. No word yet from Cass County Tourism grant packet submitted on August 19.
- 2. Fireworks stand with Wild Willie's was discussed.
 - A) Blessing was in contact with Wild Willy's and there should be no problem with NightVision. Fireworks being a 'conflict of interest'.
 - B) In 2016, Eagle, Plattsmouth and Nebraska City had closest WW fireworks stands.
 - C) January 1st is best date to shoot for to let WW know if we're going to go through with it.
 - D) Gillott suggested we check with Mike Minford about using gravel lot for stand by MVFD, as only the concrete portion is on MVFD property.
 - E) Need committed volunteers who would be willing to work the 10-day, 24/7 schedule.
 - A) Suggested were to ask MVFD, Scouts, school groups and split proceeds accordingly.
 - F) MFF needs to check with Village for any restrictions on location, even if it's on private property.
- 3. Zeigler to contact village clerk to add Hensch to agenda for October 11 Village Board meeting.
